OVERVIEW

1. The Website itself and the information provided in it along with the framework of business is a property belonging to Tradyon.
2. The information provided in the form of terms in this document governs your access to and use of our website including the Products available on it, unless expressly stated otherwise in these terms (the “Terms”).
3. In addition to the Terms, the overall agreement between you and the Company shall also constitute of the Compliance Policy and the Privacy Policy(as per stated above), as well as any other policy that may be implemented by the Company within the span of time, as referred to in these Terms.
4. **Privacy policy for data exchange and data collection:**
Our Privacy Policy, which details how we may use the data and information. We collect from you, or that you provide to us, is incorporated by reference into these Terms.
5. **Compliance policy(Ethical framework):**
Our Compliance Policy, which sets out the basic fair and ethical principles and practices Tradyon Students must adhere to in exercising their duties under the Students Agreement, is also incorporated by reference into these Terms.
6. By accessing or using our website, you acknowledge and agree to be bound by these Terms, and you represent and warrant that you have the right, authority and capacity to enter into these Terms. If you do not agree to these Terms, you must not access or use our website. We strongly advise that you save or print these Terms so you can read them whenever convenient.

DEFINITIONS:

In these Terms, unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the following meaning:

“Account”	refers to the account(s) held by Tradyon Students to fulfill their obligations under these Terms and the Students Agreement;
“Confidential Information”	means all information which is disclosed to the Students pursuant to or in connection with these Terms or the Students Agreement (whether orally or in writing or any other medium, and whether or not the information is expressly stated to be confidential or marked as such) which may include, but is not limited to, the terms in the Students Agreement, the TRD Loyalty Programme. or any other information deemed to be confidential by the Company;
“Academy Course/courses”	refers to the Academy Courses that Tradyon sells, which provides its purchasers access to our Partners’ Products;
“Inheritor”	refers to the individual who a former Student may transfer the ownership to, including the rights and obligations connected to his/ her Account as per Clause 16;
“Student Agreement”	refers to the agreements which will regulate the relationship between you and the Company, namely these Terms, the Privacy Policy and the Compliance Policy, as well as any other policy the Company may implement from time to time. The use of the definition “Student Agreement”
“Control”	means when a person directly or indirectly holds or controls a majority of the voting rights of, or the right to appoint or remove a majority of the board of directors, or the right to exercise a dominant influence over another person;
“Crossline Sponsor/ sponsoring”	refers to where a Student solicits another Student to join his/her network;
“Intellectual Property Rights/ ownership”	refers to copyrights, trademarks and any other intellectual property right;

USDT	Refers to 'Tether USDT(USDT is the symbol for Tether, a cryptocurrency that is pegged to the U.S. dollar.)'

Unless the context otherwise requires, each reference in these Terms to: “writing”, and any cognate expression, includes a reference to any communication affected by electronic(including email) or facsimile transmission or similar means; and a Clause is a reference to a Clause within these Terms.

The headings used in these Terms are for convenience only and shall have no effect upon the interpretation of the Terms. Words imparting the singular number shall include the plural and vice versa. Any words following terms such as including, include, for example, such as or any other similar expression shall not limit the sense of the words, description, definition, or phrase prior to those terms. References to persons shall include corporations.

AMENDMENTS TO THE TERMS:

We may amend these Terms and our policies over a period of time. Every time you wish to use our website, please check these Terms and our policies to ensure you understand the terms that apply at that period of time. You are always responsible for complying with the current version of these Terms and our policies.

- 1. Information regarding the website:** Our website is made available free of charge. We reserve the right (in our sole discretion) from time to time to change the Website for any reason or no reason at all. Your continued use of the Website following the posting of any changes to these Terms constitutes acceptance of those changes. You agree that the Company will not be liable to you or to any third party for any change to the Website or any part thereof.
- 2. Guarantee regarding website:** We do not guarantee that our website, or any content on it, will always be available or be uninterrupted or will always be free from errors or omissions.
- 3. Suspension or withdrawal criteria:** We may suspend or withdraw or restrict the availability of all or any part of our website for business and operational reasons. We will try to give you reasonable notice of any suspension or withdrawal.
- 4. Responsibility at user end:** You are responsible for ensuring that all persons who access our website through your internet connection are aware of these Terms and other applicable terms and conditions, and that they comply with them.

COURSES, PRODUCTS AND TERMS OF SALE:

- Tradyon sells Academy Courses that provides its purchasers with several Perks, such as access to our Partners’ Products. Accordingly, you acknowledge and agree that any Product made available on our website and by virtue of you purchasing an Academy Courses are created and produced by our Partners, not Tradyon. Hence, Tradyon shall not be liable for any matters relating to the Products.
- You understand and agree that Product descriptions, contents, suppliers, specifications and

prices may change from time to time without notice. You also acknowledge and agree that we will not be liable for any inaccuracies, warranties, representations or conditions regarding the Products' merchantability, quality, legality and safety.

3. Prior to any changes made in accordance with Clause 5.2, Students may be given prior notice through the Company's Website, email, social media, newsletter or other means as determined by the Company, but the Company shall not be obligated to do so.
4. In case of defects in the Products you purchase from the date of these Terms onwards, you shall promptly and within no later than 24 hours inform the Company by sending us an email at (support@tradyon.io). As the Products are produced by our Partners and not by us, the Company shall not be liable for any defects of or in the Products.
5. Further to Clause 5.4, the Company shall not be liable for any consequential damage, including, but not limited to, loss of profits, interest, etc.
6. Once a Student has purchased an Academic Course on our Website, any further Student purchases shall be done through the Student's back office in their Account as set out in Clause 9.11.

PAYMENT OPTIONS AND TERMS:

For any purchase of an Academic Course, the following are the available payment methods on the Website:

- i. Cryptocurrency transfer
- ii. TRADYON Gift Codes.

You must also check the website for the other available options of payment that suit your preference.

We reserve the right to change the payment options and methods as mentioned in Clause from over the period of time.

CANCELLATION AND REFUNDS:

1. If a student decides to cancel their purchase after having accessed the Academy Course or utilised the Academy Course in any way, the student may be refunded 50% of the purchase price it has paid for the cancelled Academy Course. Note that any points earned by the Student shall also be deducted from the 50% refund. In any case, any refunds and its amounts will be at the sole discretion of the Company.
2. On cancellation of a purchase, any administration fees shall not be refunded. Once a student cancels their registration, their Account shall be deleted.

THE TRD LOYALTY PROGRAMME. – TRADYON Points:

1. The TRD Loyalty Programme. is a loyalty rewards programme by Tradyon wherein the Company, in its sole discretion, may reward students with Points and/or other bonuses. The TRD Loyalty Programme. consists of Points. Through TRADYON Points, Tradyon awards students who actively purchase Academy Courses on our Website, and maintain their Academy Courses, with loyalty points.
2. To be a part of the TRD Loyalty Programme., you will have to register for an account on our website and purchase any of our Academy Courses. Once you have done so, you will then become eligible to reward Points under TRADYON Points Program.
3. Students shall be responsible for their own actions and may receive bonuses depending on their performance subject to the terms of our Compliance Policy and the TRD Loyalty Programme.

4. Students are allowed to refer potential students but shall not be obligated to do so. Nonetheless, if Members do refer potential students, such students shall be expected to provide support to their newly sponsored student(s).
5. Points that can be potentially earned by a Tradyon Students from the TRD Loyalty Programme. will be given to the student at the sole discretion of the Company. Such Points and any other bonuses are not guaranteed, and the Company is not obligated in any way whatsoever to give such Points to students.
6. You acknowledge and agree that we are entitled to make any amendments or changes to the TRD Loyalty Programme. over a period of time span.
7. Tradyon is not a financial institution. Thus, you understand and agree that the Academy Courses, the TRD Loyalty Programme., as well as the Points and other bonuses you may receive by virtue of being a student and satisfying specific conditions, are not, and shall not be considered as financial products, nor are they intended to be financial products.

STUDENT REGISTRATION AND ACCOUNT:

To purchase an Academy Course and become a TRADYON Student, you must register an Account and provide certain information as prompted by the Account registration form. You represent and warrant that: all required registration information you submit is truthful and accurate; and you will maintain the accuracy of such information.

Any individual interested in becoming a student shall be at least eighteen (**18**) years old and shall register through a referral link of an existing student.

The Company is entitled to request any necessary information from the potential student for Know Your Client ("**KYC**") purposes. The Company shall reserve its right to reject any application at its own discretion with or without providing a reason.

Each Student must have one account.

For each Account, during the registration, a username and password must be set, which, upon completion of the registration, shall become the student's log in detail. You acknowledge that the detail and information you submit upon registration is your responsibility and is submitted at your own risk.

If a married couple register as students, the Company shall permit the married couple to either have separate Student Accounts, which they will be separately responsible for, or a joint Account. In case of a joint Account, the married couple shall be jointly responsible for fulfilling their obligations under these Terms and the Student Agreement. In case of a divorce or separation, both spouses shall provide a document specifying who will continue running the joint Account one (1) month from the date of separation. If the spouses fail to provide such a document, the Company shall assume the first spouse mentioned on the student registration form to be the sole owner of the joint Account.

In accordance with Clause 9.5, the married couple shall either have the same sponsor or one spouse can sponsor the other in case they have separate Accounts. Students are responsible for keeping their Account details accurate and up to date. In the event of changes, Students are required to make written requests to the Company's IT department via email to TRADYON support team. Once the request has been received, KYC procedures may be conducted if necessary. Once the changes have been confirmed and proven, the changes shall be made. A student may request to change their sponsor. In this case, the student's Account shall be closed.

The student can make a new application with their desired sponsor after a period of 75 weeks, however, this time period can be decreased or increased at the discretion of the Company. Approval or rejection of

such an application will be at the sole discretion of the Company. You are responsible for maintaining the confidentiality of your Account login information and are fully responsible for all activities that occur under your Account. You agree to immediately notify the Company of any unauthorised use or suspected unauthorised use of your Account or any other breach of security.

The Company cannot and will not be liable for any loss or damage arising from your failure to comply with the above requirements.

Once you have created an Account, you will be given access to a back office wherein you will be provided with information relating to the Products available on our Website, the TRD Loyalty Programme, and any Points and/or other bonuses you have earned. You acknowledge and agree that the back office shall undergo maintenance from time to time and that you shall not alter, change or modify any data and/or information in the back office.

Further to Clause 9.10, Students shall use the back office to make any further Academy Courses purchases. The student understands that once they log in to their Account and connect it to their Academy Course, the Academy Course will be deemed activated and used.

These Terms will remain in full force and effect while you use any part of the Website and the Products. We may suspend or terminate your rights to use the Website (including your Account) at any time for any reason at our sole discretion. Such reasons can include, but are not limited to, any use of the Website in violation of the Student Agreement, any malicious behavior, acts of misrepresentation of Tradyon, etc. Upon termination of your rights under the Student Agreement, your Student(s), Account and right to access and use the Website and the Products will terminate immediately. You agree that any termination of your Account may involve deletion of any user content associated with it, including any figures, documentation or material in your back office. The Company will have no liability whatsoever to you for any termination of your rights under these Terms and the Student Agreement, including for the termination of your Account or deletion of your user content.

TRD LOYALTY PROGRAMME. AND REDEMPTION:

The students understand and agree that relevant information relating to the TRD Loyalty Programme, is provided to you through your Account's back office or in any other manner as the Company deems necessary. You acknowledge and agree that we are entitled to make any amendments or changes to such information relating to the TRD Loyalty Programme, from time to time.

1. TRADYON Points & Compensation plan set out the Points and other bonuses payable to students upon satisfying the conditions for the same and at the Company's sole discretion. Any bonuses points and/or other bonuses shall be transferred to the student's respective wallets as per the TRD Loyalty Programme.
2. We may conduct KYC procedures in relation to redemptions from the student's wallet. Likewise, we may also conduct KYC procedures prior to any peer-to-peer TRADYON wallet transfers.
3. If you believe there has been an error regarding any of your bonuses, you must notify us within ten (10) days from the date of the error. You acknowledge that any errors brought to our attention after these ten (10) days expire shall no longer be our responsibility.
4. The Company may set a minimum amount for redemption, which the Company can change at its sole discretion from time to time. An administration fee of 10% shall be charged per redemption.
5. It should be noted that third parties (i.e. payment service providers and banks) have their own terms and conditions, which you shall review. If your Account name as approved in the KYC is different to the one in the bank account, payment shall not be processed.
6. You shall be solely responsible for VAT registration and for any duties concerning your financial

statements. You understand that you are solely responsible for the payment of any applicable taxes, and we shall not be liable for the same.

ADVERTISING AND PROMOTING ACADEMY COURSES:

These Terms, including the Compliance Policy and any other policy that may be implemented by Tradyon from time to time, shall govern your activities in relation to marketing, advertising and/or promoting our Academy Courses. You understand and agree that any breach of the following Terms, including those within our Compliance Policy and/or any of our other policies, shall entitle us to take actions against you as we deem necessary, including, but not limited to, terminating your Academy Courses, suspending or taking down your Account, revoking any Points and/or other bonuses you may have earned through means of a breach of the Student Agreement, restricting your access to any of our Partners' Products, etc. 11.2 Our name Tradyon is a trademark and shall remain our exclusive property students are not permitted to use our trademarks, including those of our Partners, and other intellectual property rights for any purpose, including for business or personal use or under any circumstance unless we have provided written consent to the same and they are used subject to these Terms and the Student Agreement.

Students shall not modify, change, alter or create their own trademarks or other intellectual property rights concerning the Company's logos, trade names and designs, including those of our Partners and their Products. This also includes any marketing material provided by Tradyon to Students.

Students are strictly prohibited from creating their own marketing material, including, but not limited to, advertisements, social media posts, articles, statements, photos, illustrations and any other type of promotional material in relation to Tradyon and/or our Academy Courses only Tradyon shall be entitled to prepare such materials.

Students can download Tradyon approved. marketing materials from our Website and/ or through the student's back office and shall only use such materials in accordance with these Terms and our Compliance Policy.

Terms and conditions regarding marketing material:

You understand and agree that any marketing material that you have created, including any amendments you have made to Tradyon's approved marketing materials, without the prior written consent of Tradyon shall be considered a breach of these Terms and our Compliance Policy. You acknowledge and agree that you are prohibited from making any false or fraudulent representations about the Company, our Academy Courses, our Partners' Products, as well as the TRD Loyalty Programme. or potentials of bonuses. This also applies to the referring of potential Students.

You acknowledge and agree that all the Company's materials are copyrighted and shall not be reproduced, partly or fully, unless the Company provides their written consent for you to do so. This is regardless of the material's form, whether it is digital or printed. As set out by Clause 8.7, Tradyon is not a financial institution, thus, Students cannot promote and/or market Tradyon as such.

Terms and conditions for material provided to student by the company:

Students are prohibited from making any recordings, both in audio or video, of speeches, discussions or presentations by the Company as well as its employees, officers, agents or representatives without the Company's prior written consent.

Likewise, Students are prohibited from posting and/or publishing such recordings online without the Company's prior written consent. In the event that we give our written approval, Students shall not change, modify or transfer any press releases, pictures or recordings for their own personal advertising

benefit. In accordance with Clause 11.9,

Students are also prohibited from making any audio or video recordings or recordings in any form whatsoever, and posting and/or publishing the same online, of any speaker or celebrity presentations or appearances at a Company event unless the Students has acquired prior written authorisation from us.

Following Clause 11.10, Students are not allowed to use, reuse, display or distribute through any medium any image or any form whatsoever of the speaker or celebrity wherein it may misconstrue the Product as a celebrity endorsed advertisement unless we have approved so in writing

The Company shall notify students through email or social media concerning Company events. The timing and location of such events shall be at the sole discretion of the Company and may be changed, postponed or cancelled if the Company deems necessary.

Terms and conditions that should every student acknowledge:

You acknowledge that you are not allowed to:

- violate any policies, rules and regulations set by us. imply or suggest that materials not belonging to the Company are owned by the Company.
- resell the Academy Course for a lower price compared to its original purchase price. resell the Academy Course on any other online or offline public or private markets, department stores or auctions.
- sell marketing or promotional material to other students. send spam messages, faxes or emails to others; and use our name, including those of our Partners, for your own personal benefit, which includes, but is not limited to, applying for loans or incurring expenses

Students are permitted to purchase the Academy Course for their families and for personal use provided that it is done so in accordance with the Student Agreement.

Students acknowledge that they shall not act as a spokesperson for the Company and shall not make any statements on behalf of the Company. Any enquiries by the media in relation to the Company shall be immediately referred to us.

Students are entitled to present themselves as Students of the TRD Loyalty Programme. Students shall not misrepresent their Academy Course in the same and claim that they are a part of the Company. Accordingly, all business cards, name tags or personal websites shall include correct and accurate information.

You acknowledge that merely becoming a Student shall not entitle you to Points and other bonuses. The Company only rewards you with Points and/or other bonuses in its sole direction and, in the event that we do, it shall be directly related to your performance in marketing and/or promoting our Academy Course and as set out in the TRD Loyalty Programme.

You shall be responsible for any costs you incur in fulfilling your obligations under these Terms and the Student Agreement. This shall include, but is not limited to, the payment for your own equipment and tools, transportation, lodging, office and other expenses.

You acknowledge that you shall be responsible for paying all applicable federal and national taxes in relation to any Points and/or other bonuses you may receive under the TRD Loyalty Programme.

Students shall only conduct their marketing, promotional and advertising activities in locations where they are legally allowed to do so, and the Company will not be liable whatsoever for any actions of the Students.

Students shall be fully responsible for any third-party claims arising from their breach of the Student Agreement or any of their activities in relation to being a Student of the TRD Loyalty Programme.

You shall ensure that you act responsibly and fulfil your obligations under the Student Agreement and any applicable laws and regulations.

You shall inform us immediately if you become aware of any kind of violation from clause 11 or any provision of the student agreement by contacting us via email. That is: support@tradyon.io

UNETHICAL BUSINESS PRACTISES:

You acknowledge that you are strictly prohibited from targeting any individuals in your downline organisation as this will be deemed improper business practice and will subject you to the suspension of your Account.

Students are also strictly prohibited from providing misleading or fraudulent information for the purposes of their marketing and promotional activities of our Academy Course under the TRD Loyalty Programme.

Cross line Sponsoring, or attempting to do so, is not permitted and shall be considered a breach of the Student Agreement leading to suspension of the involved Students Accounts. You understand that manipulation of Points and/or other bonuses as specified in the TRD Loyalty Programme. is strictly not allowed. This shall include, but is not limited to, altering Account details, performances and/or results. Any attempt to do so shall result in the withdrawal of any Points and/or other bonuses you may be entitled to and suspension of your Account.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR TERMINATION OF CONTRACT BETWEEN COMPANY AND STUDENT:

The Student Agreement shall form the entire agreement between the Student and the Company. The term of the Student Agreement shall be indefinite and may be immediately terminated by the Company without any notice to the student. The student may also terminate the Student Agreement by giving a 14 days' written notice to the Company. The Company may immediately terminate the Student Agreement, and the Academy Course Account, upon the following events:

Student Cross line Sponsors; gross negligence, willful misconduct or fraud of the Student; failure of the Member to remedy their substantial breach of any provisions of the Student Agreement after being given reasonable time to do so as per Clause 15;

1. Student breaches provisions in relation to our Confidential Information and Intellectual Property Rights.
2. Students become subject to an administration order.
3. Students cease, or threaten to cease, to carry on business.
4. Control of the Student (in the event that the student is a company) is acquired by any person or connected persons not having Control of that Student upon the date of entering into these Terms and the Student Agreement; and/or
5. Students become subject to a bankruptcy order or go into liquidation.

For the purposes of Clause 13.2.3, a breach shall be considered capable of remedy if the student can comply with all obligations and duties under these Terms and the Student Agreement in all respects.

The rights to terminate the Student Agreement, including the Academy Courses and Account, given by

this Clause 13 shall not prejudice any other right or remedy of both the Student and the Company in respect of the breach concerned (if any) or any other breach.

RESULTS OF TERMINATION:

Upon termination, the Academy Course and Account shall be terminated and all funds which the student is entitled to shall be transferred to them subject to Clause 14.2. The student shall return to the Company any and all materials and documentation which includes the Company's and/or our Partners' and their Products' name, Confidential Information, Intellectual Property Rights, as well as any such material owned by the Company or our Partners. Such material and/or documentation shall no longer be used by the student.

The Student acknowledges and agrees that in the event that the Student Agreement was terminated by Tradyon due to the Student's negligence or breach of any provision of the same, TRADYON shall have the sole discretion to revoke any of the Points and/or other bonuses the Student has earned through means of a breach of the Student Agreement and/or retain the whole or a part of the amounts in their Account's wallets.

The student understands that once the Student Agreement has been terminated, the student no longer has the right to receive any Points and/or bonuses generated after the termination. For clarity, any calculation of the Student's Points and/or bonuses shall immediately halt up to the point of the effectiveness of any notice of termination of the Student Agreement as set out in Clause 13.

All clauses which, either expressly or by their nature, relate to the period after the expiry or termination of the Student Agreement shall remain in full force and effect after termination. Termination shall not affect or prejudice any right to damages or other remedy which the Company may have in respect of the event giving rise to the termination or any other right to damages or other remedy which the Company may have in respect of any breach of these Terms and the Student Agreement which existed at or before the date of termination.

The termination shall not have any effect on the obligations already due between the Student and the Company.

Students who terminate their Student Agreements may still reapply to become Student. The Company will have sole discretion in deciding whether or not to accept any application to become a student and whether or not to impose any conditions on reapplying to become a Student. Regardless of the Student reapplying under the same or a different sponsor, the Student shall be placed at the bottom of the sponsor's downline organisation.

INVESTIGATION AND RECTIFICATION OF BREACH:

In the event that the student has breached, or Tradyon has a reason to believe the student has breached, any of the provisions of the Student Agreement, the Company shall directly start an investigation:

Throughout the duration of Tradyon's investigation of the breach or the suspected activity, the Student's Account and cash wallet, along with the Points and other this Clause 15.1. The Company may provide the student a reasonable time to remedy the breach along with suspending the Students Account. The Company may give the student ten (10) days to remedy the breach but will still be entitled to grant a lesser or greater period. It should be noted that the student shall not have access to his/her cash wallet, but the student shall continue to receive any Points and/or other bonuses on their Account unless decided otherwise by the Company.

If the Student fixes the breach or becomes successful in proving the accusation(s) is/ are not valid, the

case shall be closed, and the Student's Account and cash wallet shall be released.

If the Student fails to remedy the breach or fails to disprove the accusation(s), the Company shall be entitled to immediately terminate the Student Agreement as per

Clause 13 and all bonuses the Student is entitled to shall be transferred to their TRADYON Active Income wallet subject to Clause 14.

Following Clause 15.1, Tradyon may also temporarily suspend and freeze the Student's Account in the event that the Company suspects:

- Any suspicious or malicious activities.
- System hacks.
- Unverified KYC documents, bank account details, wallet addresses, etc.; or Other events which the Company believes gives rise to the need for further investigation.

TRANSFER OF ACCOUNT:

Students are permitted to transfer their rights of ownership over their Account to an Inheritor at any time provided the Company's prior written consent is acquired as well as a signed agreement between the Student and the Inheritor is provided, which clearly states that the student shall transfer their rights and that the Inheritor agrees and fully understands the terms in the Student Agreement.
